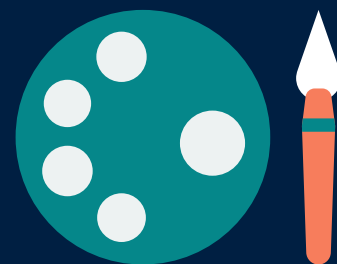
Computing

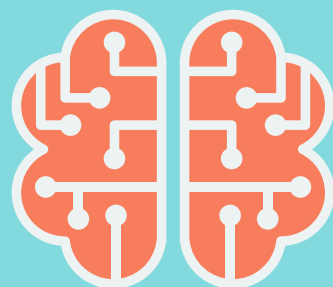
Psychology and Criminology

- Organ system model: can you identify the organs?

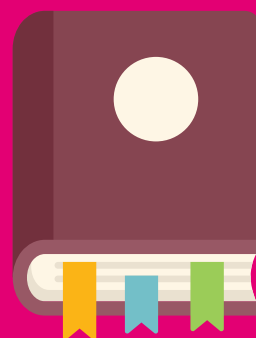
Chemistry practical activities

Shaping the Future of Food, Fabric, and Innovation.

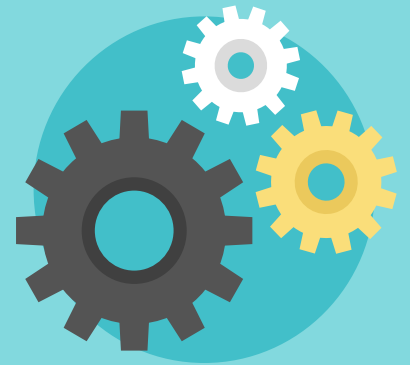
Visit our technology departments and get stuck in with some tasty tasters, and creative stitch work.
