A Level Science Study Skills Trip

As part of the A Level Science programme of study, a study skills trip has been arranged for students to take part in. This visit is due to take place on Thursday 7th November in Liverpool City Centre.

The purpose of this session is to improve student confidence with independent study and provide vital skills that will help students to prepare for their summer exams.

Students will depart from school at approximately 9.00 a.m. and arrive at Breakout Liverpool for an escape room at 10.30 a.m. Students will then have time to get their lunch (not provided) before arriving at the Liverpool Central Library where a tour of the library will take place. Students will then access the conference rooms at the library in order to take part in a session on study skills and developing independent study. This is relevant for all A Level Science courses. This session will take place from 1.30 p.m. - 3.30 p.m. and students will be dismissed from the library and make their own way home.

Students are not expected to wear uniform, but are expected to dress sensibly. Students will be expected to pay for their own transport on the day as we will be using the public bus.
