Dear Parent/Carer

It is with great pleasure and enthusiasm I write to inform you about the arrangements of our upcoming sports day on Monday, 14th July. Your child will be expected to be in school no later than 8.30 a.m. with the day set to finish at approximately 1.00 p.m.

Key information regarding the day:

- All students <u>competing</u> in an event are to wear <u>school PE kit</u> and to arrive in school in this attire as there will be no time to change. Students not competing in an event should wear school uniform as per a normal school day.
- > The timings of the school day will change to accommodate the events, an extended break time will enable pupils to have hot food.
- ➤ Please keep a look out for the weather forecast as sun cream and plenty of water may be needed. If the weather is less favourable, then ensure your child has a school PE jumper to wear to keep warm.
- > Sports day will continue to take place if it is raining, however events will change accordingly, plain black waterproof jackets are permitted.
- Students are to always follow the school behaviour policy and are not permitted to take their mobile 'phones to the sports field. They are to lock them in their lockers when they first arrive in school in the morning and collect them at the end of the day as normal.
- All students are to depart St John Bosco Arts College at approximately 12.50 p.m. The school bus has been changed to reflect this and will depart at 1.00 p.m.
