Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of your child's Geography GCSE course, they must carry out two, **compulsory**, fieldwork trips in the local area. The department has arranged for Year 10 to visit Ainsdale beach in order to carry out primary data collection. The write up for this visit will be examined in Paper 3 of their terminal exams, which is worth 30% of their final grade.
