I am writing to you today regarding RNIB Bookshare.

RNIB Bookshare provide textbooks and materials that support the UK curriculum. They offer a range of accessible formats that can be read electronically or adapted to suit the personal reading needs of learners. They now have over one million titles with more being added all the time.

Membership of RNIB Bookshare is free to educators within schools in the UK who are supporting print-disabled learners and allows school to download curriculum resources, including textbooks and accessible images. This means that it is free for students to use.

The SENDCo has identified that your child qualifies to use RNIB Bookshare (please see accompanying information booklet for further guidance on qualifying print disabilities such as dyslexia, autism or visual impairment).

Your child will receive account login details for the platform/app and be able to download accessible formats of curriculum textbooks, subject reading books as well as reading books for fun.
