Dear Parent/Carer

It is with great pleasure and enthusiasm I write to inform you about the arrangements of our upcoming sports day on **Tuesday, 14th July**. It truly is a great Salesian event whereby all staff and students pull together to put on a wonderful, celebratory day of activities and athletic events. Your child will be expected to be in school no later than **8.30 a.m.** with the day set to finish at approximately **1.00 p.m.**

Key information regarding the day:

- All students competing in an event must arrive to school wearing their **school PE kit**. Due to the predicted warm weather all other students are welcome to wear their PE Kits if they wish.
- The timings of the school day will change to accommodate the events; an extended break time will enable pupils to have hot food.
- Please note that warm and sunny weather is forecast for next Tuesday. To help your child stay safe and comfortable, please ensure they arrive with sun cream already applied, a named water bottle filled with water, and a sun hat or cap.
- We will monitor the weather throughout the day and adapt activities if needed. This may include using additional shaded areas, increasing water breaks, reducing more strenuous activities, or moving some events indoors if temperatures become too high.
- Students are to always follow the school behaviour policy and are **not permitted to take their mobile 'phones** to the sports field. They are to lock them in their lockers when they first arrive in school in the morning and collect them at the end of the day as normal.
- As per usual this is a weather dependant event and changes to the event may be made based upon weather conditions on the day.
- **All students are to depart St John Bosco Arts College at approximately 12.50 p.m. The school bus has been changed to reflect this and will depart at 1.00 p.m.**

Finally, we wish all our students good luck in their events on the day and for those who are not competing, cheer and support as loud and as encouragingly as possible to make it a memorable day for all involved. Unfortunately, no spectators are allowed onsite to watch the events.
