- Repeating Year 12 in order to strengthen subject knowledge and improve outcomes.

These decisions are never taken lightly and will always involve discussion with students and parents/carers to ensure the best possible pathway forward.

We strongly encourage all students to make full use of the support available to them, including attending every lesson, completing all assignments, revising effectively, and seeking help from their teachers when needed.
