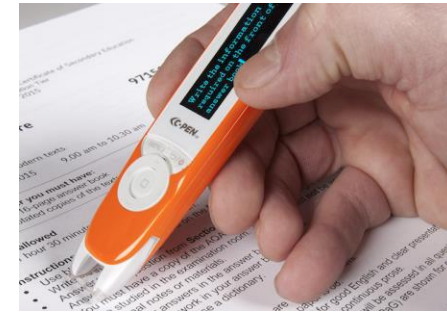

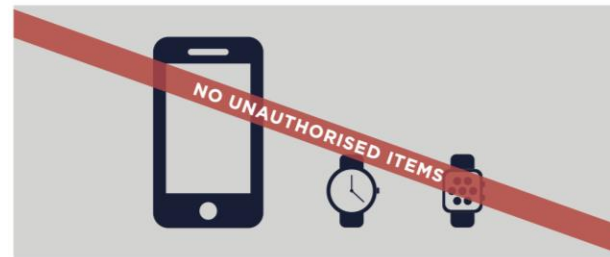

- Please ensure you read the school policy and familiarise yourself with the key points.

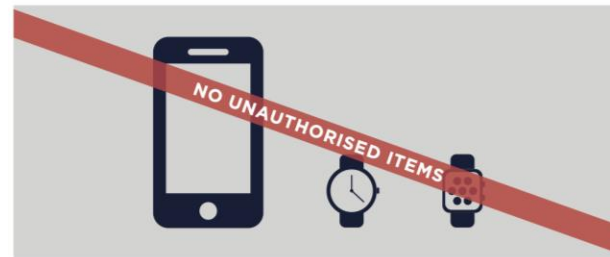

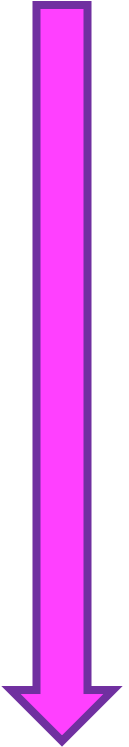
