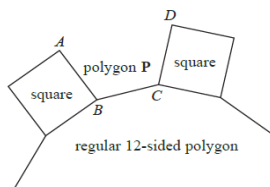

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Exam Regulations

D. Instructions during the exam

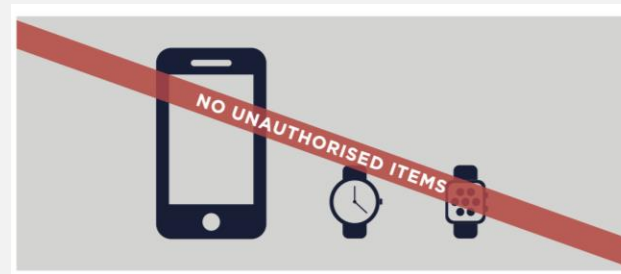
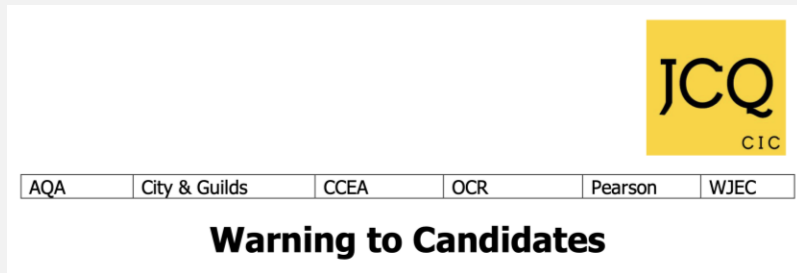

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Exam Regulations

- Breaking any rules or regulations could lead to disqualification from all subjects.
- The school must report any breach of regulations to the Exam Board.
- Other important information for candidates
 - 'Warning to Candidates' poster
 - 'No Unauthorised Items' poster



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Exam Regulations

- As soon as you walk into the venue you must be in “examination conditions”
- You should make every effort to go to the toilet before your examination. You cannot leave the exam in the first hour or the last 15mins. Any toilet visits must be supervised by an invigilator.
- At the end of the examination, you will be dismissed a row at a time by the chief invigilator. You must remain in examination conditions until you are out of the building.
- If you intentionally try to cheat in a GCSE, or mock GCSE examination, this has to be reported to JCQ (Joint Council for Qualifications). This can result in being disqualified from all subjects.
